And we do command all and every Our Justices named in Our said Commissioned for our aforesaid District to receive you as their Associate and further we do hereby command our sheriff of our said District and all constables and other Peace offices in our aforesaid District and all others our liege subjects therein to pay due obedience to you as Our Justice by the Presents assigned.

In Testimony thereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our said Province to be hereunto affixed. Witness Our Right Trusty and Right Well. Beloved Cousin James Earl of Elgin and Kincardine Knight of the most ancient and most Noble Order of the Thistle Governor General of British North America and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and the Island of Prince Edward and Vice Admiral of the same Vc__Vc__ at Toronto, in our Province of Canada, this fifteenth day of November in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine, and in the thirteenth year of our reign.
