And Our Royal Will and Pleasure further is that the said James Edward Small after taking and subscribing the Oaths by Law required to be taker in that behalf do and shall take his Seat at the Board of Our said Executive Council accordingly as a Member thereof as aforesaid, and do and shall during the continuance of this Our Commission have rank and precedence within Our said Province of Canada next and after The Honorable Thomas Cushing Aylwin
In testimony whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our said Province to be hereunto affixed;[] Our Right Trusty and well beloved Sir Charles Bagot G.C.B.
