Toronto 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept 1837

Dear Sir

I am in receipt of your letter of 19<sup>th</sup> sept [sic] in which you [enclose] a [Cheque *word cut off from image* ] on the Bank of Upper Canada for £9 [unknown symbol] to be placed to the Credit of W. Stayner [unknown word] Mr. [Lead's?] note for £200 due 9<sup>th</sup> december [sic] to be deposited in the Bank for collection.
