second ----- day of October now next ensuing,  
to answer to Edward Turley --- in a plea of trespass on the case upon promises  
And have you then and there this Writ.  
Witness Thomas Taylor, Esquire, Judge of the said District Court at Hamilton, this  
twenty seventh day of September – in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and thirty ----- and the first year of our Reign.
