

Toronto 28 July 1837

My Dear Sir

Mr Keble when he landed on
your letter said he would return in a day
or two from Buffalo and take the answer
but I have not seen him since and therefore
conclude I had better give you what information
I can by Post.

I cannot find that General
Piton ever drew any Lands in Buffalo or
indeed in any other Township in this Province
if you mean the General Piton who fell
at Watutao I don't see how he could do as
he never was in the Country or any of his
Family, or is it some person whose Christian
name is General, but I cannot find any person
of that name in Buffalo
