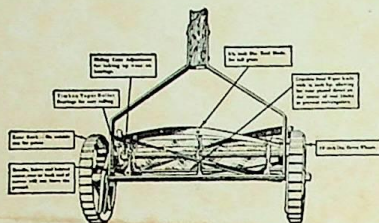

A Heavy Duty Lawn Mower

So constructed that the back or roller end will not leave the ground, as do all others, when the heavy growth is struck. The Dixon Mower will cling tighter to the ground as the work gets heavier. In the construction of the Dixon Lawn Mower we use the best material we can buy. Ten-inch drive wheels—crucible steel knives—four blades with such a spiral twist that they have the five-blade effect. Drive wheels have gear rack on outside rim, giving lots of power. Reel is $6\frac{3}{8}$ " in diameter, two tie rods—one in front and one at the back end—making for sturdiness and firmness of the frame.

Only revolving blade mower made that you can turn around and pull and still cut grass. This method allows you to trim under bushes and shrubbery.

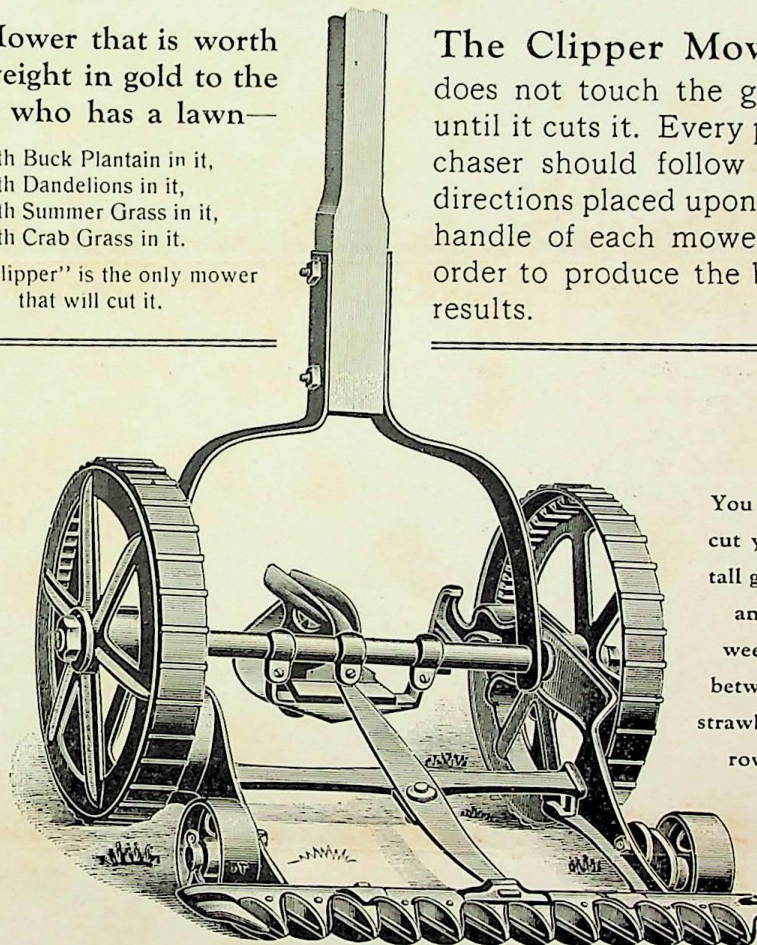

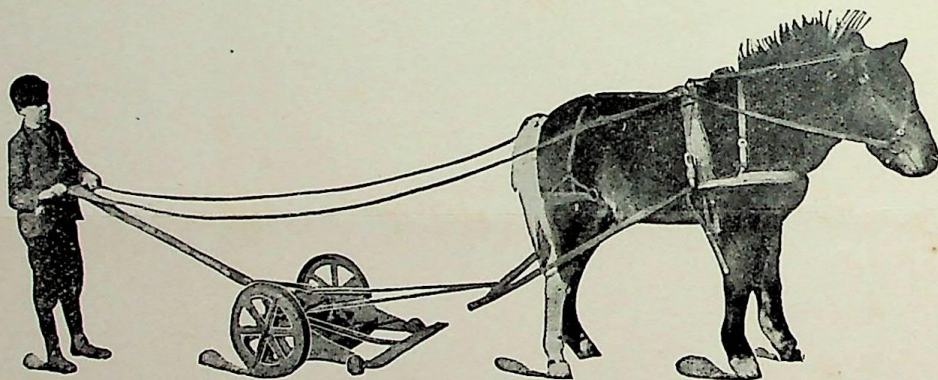
Dandelions, buck plantain and crab grass in some sections have secured such a hold on the lawns that it is almost impossible to keep a sod on them. You should start to cut the dandelions as soon as the seed tops begin to open, so the seeds cannot mature. Pay no attention to the roots; they will soon decay and disappear. Buck plantain should be treated the same way.

Crab grass should be cut before the seeds mature. You will find it goes to seed in June and August.

The above, if followed, will rid your lawn of these pests, as dandelions, etc., root only on bald spots on the lawn. If the grass is allowed to stool and spread out, it will choke these weeds from the lawn.

Experimenting for years has proven this to be correct. The Clipper is the only mower that will cut the above weeds and allow the grass to thicken.

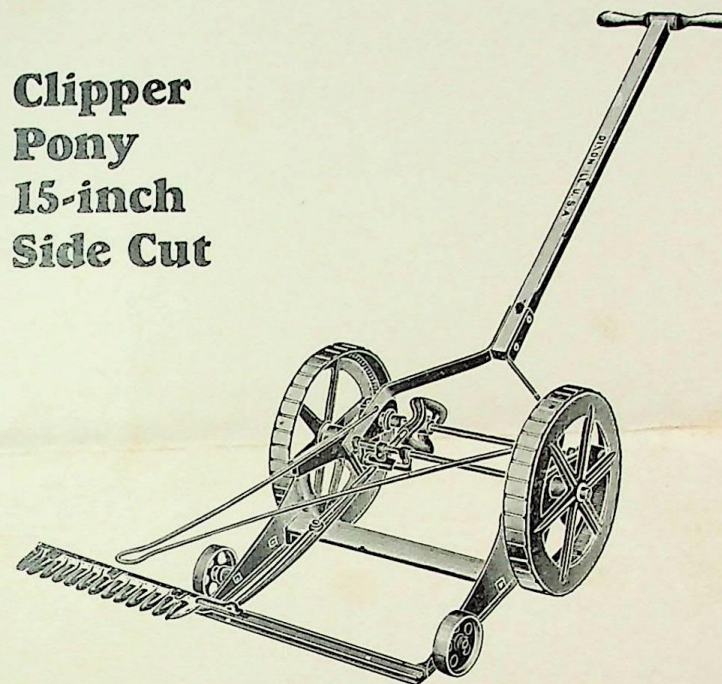
In introducing the "Clipper" to you we wish to impress upon your mind that there is no use for sickle or shears where the "Clipper" is used.



THE "PONY" MOWER

The "Pony" Mower has a cutter bar 24 inches long. The wheels are 15 inches in height. The face of the wheels is two inches. The handle is much heavier than that of the hand mower. A V-shaped drag-bar is attached to handle irons, to which pony is attached. The mower's weight is about 85 pounds. One man can run it on the level and cut the grass, but its weight is against it in cutting up hill.

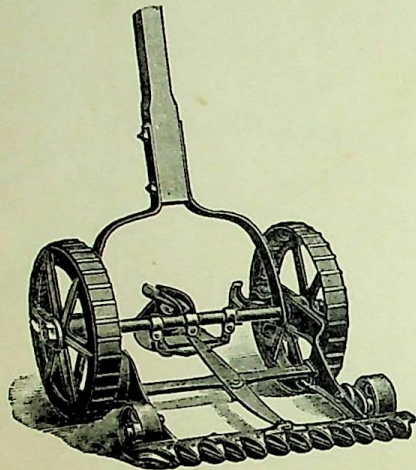
