

# Fountain Pen Directions

**NOTICE:** Please fill pen with water and shake out through nozzle before filling with ink.

1.—To fill the Pen, unscrew the section in which the pen is placed, and fill the barrel or reservoir nearly full with good fluid ink, using the glass filler that accompanies the Pen; then replace the point section by screwing it firmly into the barrel.

2.—Before filling the Pen with ink, when new or dry, fill the barrel with clear water, replace the point section, and shake all the water out, so as to thoroughly wet the pen and feed-tube. This operation a few times repeated will effectually clean the Pen if it becomes foul from using bad ink. The pen does not require to be removed from the point to clean it.

3.—If the ink is sluggish and does not move to the point of the pen readily, a slight jar will bring it; or turn the Pen over and draw the back of the pen across the blotter or pad, pressing the feed bar against pen. But if good clean ink is used no shaking is required to obtain a ready flow.

4.—Never mix inks in the Pen. If you wish to use a different ink, thoroughly wash out the Pen before filling with the new ink.

5.—Be careful not to let your Pen get empty and remain so; and use special care in selecting inks, never filling from a bottle that has long been standing open, exposed to air and dust.

6.—In removing the point cover or cap do not pull it off straight; a slight twist will easily remove it, if it fits tightly.

7.—Carry in the pocket with the pen up. It can be laid flat on the table without leaking.

8.—Do not use copying ink.

9.—Every pen fully guaranteed.
