## 35 Attend Meeting At Victor School

### Advantages of Forming New High School District To Be Studied By Groups

Committees were appointed to study the advantages and disadvantages of forming one large consolidated high school district in eastern Poweshiek county and surrounding area Wednesday night in a meeting at Victor.

#### Proposed District

The proposed new high school would include five schools—Guernsey, Hartwick, Brooklyn, Victor, and Ladora. The consolidation would be in line with a present move in the state to form larger high schools and to deny state aid to small, in-

#### Registration Fee

#### 5 Study Groups

Five study subcommittees were appointed Wednesday night and another meeting tentatively set for Jan. 16 at Victor. There will be seven persons on each subcommittee.

The subcommittees and their chairmen:

1—Area and Population, Geo. Norden of Guernsey

2—School Program or Curriculum, Merl Norden of Victor

3—Building and School Plant Facilities, Bill Dale, Brooklyn

4—Transportation, Harold Nail, Ladora

5—Finance, Wayne Ryan, Hartwick.

The study is expected to ex-

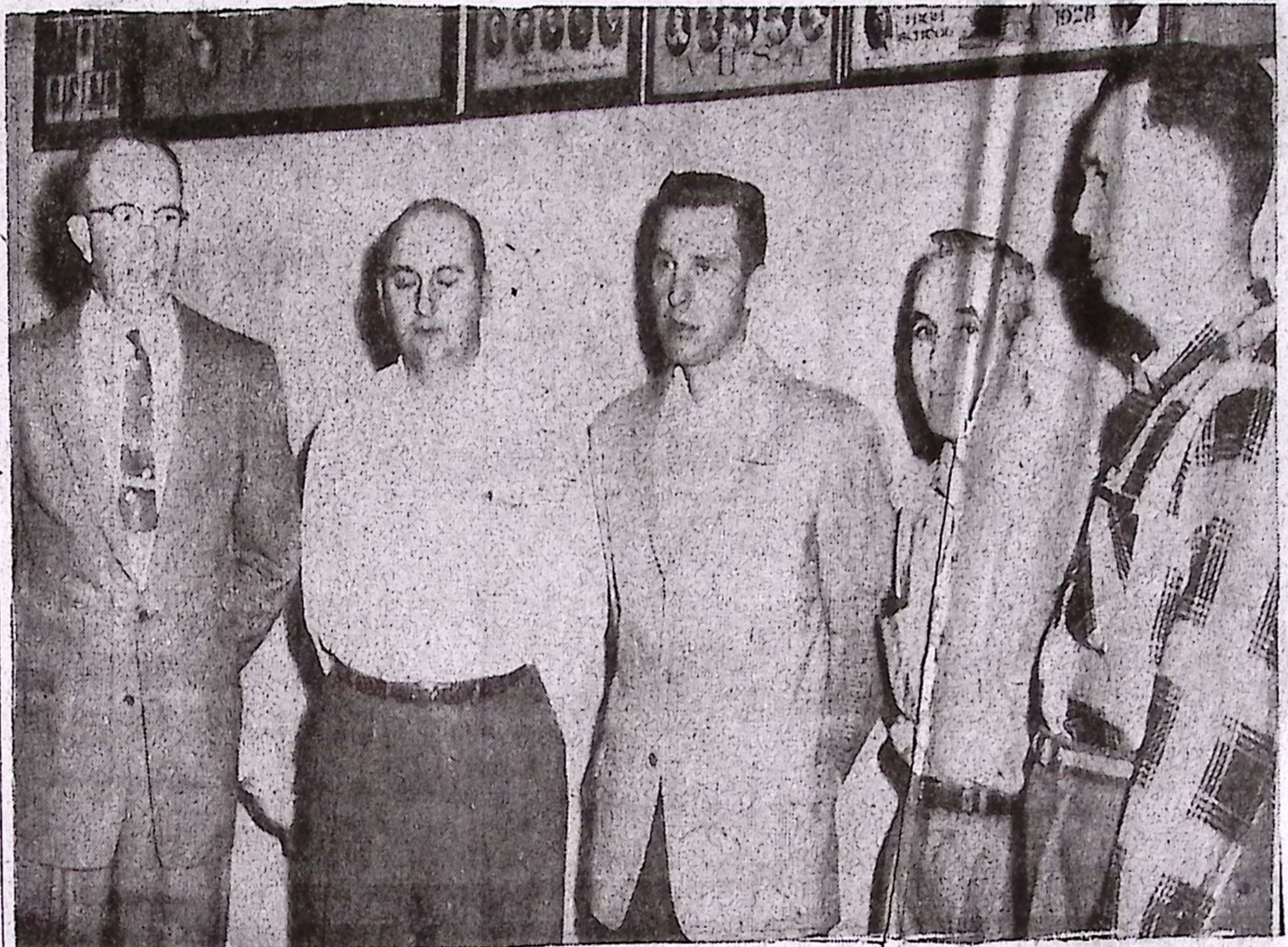
tend over a period of several months or longer.

#### Election Needed

If the study committees find that such reorganization is desirable, steps will be taken to have an election to form one school district in all these areas.

This district would operate one high school which would be centrally located and would operate elementary schools in each of the five towns.
