Saugatuck is conveniently located and can be reached from most middle western cities in a short time. We are but 135 miles from Chicago, 180 miles from Detroit, 38 miles from Grand Rapids, 400 miles from St. Louis, Mo., 310 miles from Cincinnati, and about 300 miles from Cleveland, Ohio. Saugatuck can truthfully be called "the hub of America's vacationland.

Transportation is no problem when coming to Twin Gables. For the motorist, scenic, well paved highways lead directly to our front door. The Greyhound buses are just as convenient. Chicago-ans and Detroiters can come via the Chesapeake and Ohio R.R. Those who choose to sail will find excellent docking accommodations available nearby.

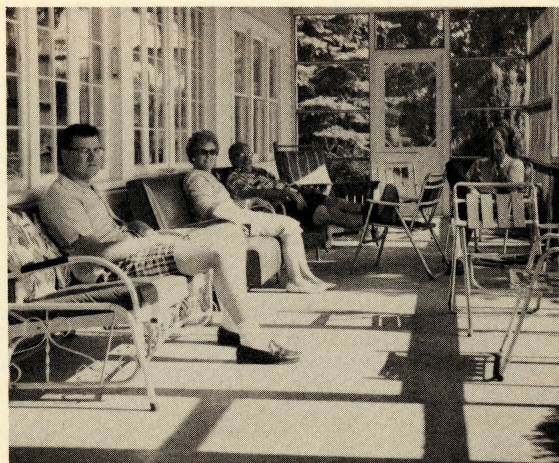

RECREATION

Our management, being ardent sportsmen, will divulge their favorite fishing spots to guests who wish to indulge in the sport while they are here.

The harbor and docking facilities make Saugatuck a most welcome port to any yachtsman. The Saugatuck Sunday sailboat races and the annual Chicago to Saugatuck yacht race are thrilling events to witness. You can skipper a pedal boat which is available for a small rental fee, or paddle a sleek canoe down the scenic Kalamazoo.

Sightseeing trips down the Kalamazoo River aboard one of the few remaining stern-wheelers is a thrill you will long remember.

The Oval, one of the country's finest bathing beaches, is just the thing for a healthful sunbath or a refreshing swim. This parklike area, located on the shores of Lake Michigan, is maintained by the village and is a natural for both an afternoon picnic and a night beach party. Experienced life guards patrol the beach, thus making swimming here as safe as a dip in your own bathtub. An added convenience to you is that we are located closer to the beach by land route than any other hotel on the town side of Saugatuck.

Golfers will find a round of their favorite game very enjoyable at the nearby sporty West Shore Golf Club. This 18 hole course has excellent greens and watered fairways.
