

According to the National Fire Protection
Association [NFPA], fireboats serve three
basic functions:

1) Rescue operations and transporting
personnel to and from incidents.

2) Stable platform for marine firefighting,
command post, recovery, medical
emergencies, and environmental
emergencies.

3) Play a critical role in water supply for
land-based fire operations.


