GIRL TARS PASS MUSKEGON.

Sloop Lady Eileen, Manned by Misses Wright and Cary, Still in the Chicago-Mackinac Race.

Muskegon, Mich., Aug. 5.—[Special.]—Although reports have been sent out that the sloop Lady Eileen, the only boat in the Chicago-Mackinac race manned by feminine sailors, had put in at South Haven because of the storm and would not venture any farther in the race, the craft lay in at Muskegon all day today.

"We will stick in the race for the whole month of August and reach Mackinac if there is a stick of canvas left to sail the boat," said Miss Wright. "Since leaving South Haven we have had fair weather and we expect to reach our destination before another week is over. The boat has met with no accident so far, and is well provisioned."

Miss Wright and Miss Cary are cousins and live at 219 Jackson Park terrace. Their craft is a center board boat.
