

WIFE TIES UP NEW FORTUNE OF "BUTTERFLY MAN"

Andrew Hay Crawford's \$200,000, this being the latest addition to his fortune, was tied up yesterday by his wife, Mrs. Evelyn Wright Crawford, who is suing for divorce. Crawford, known as "The Butterfly Man" because of his flitting propensities in the cabaret world, is in California.

Crawford is the son of the late Andrew Crawford, capitalist. Richard Crawford, brother of Andrew Hay Crawford, said his brother received \$50,000 from his father's estate in 1906, \$50,000 in 1908, and \$100,000 in 1910, and in 1913 he was broke. Recently he received \$200,000 from the estate of his mother. It is this Mrs. Crawford's suit has tied up.

Crawford's attorneys pleaded that the injunction of the wife will leave Crawford penniless, but the matter was set for Feb. 2. Crawford is accused of drunkenness and cruelty.
