Make into a thin batter: 1 pint of flour, 1 tablespoonful cornmeal, half-teaspoonful salt. Set in a warm place to rise. After it has risen, pour into it two quarts flour, with sufficient warm water to make up a loaf of bread. Work it well, set it to rise again, and when risen sufficiently, bake it.
