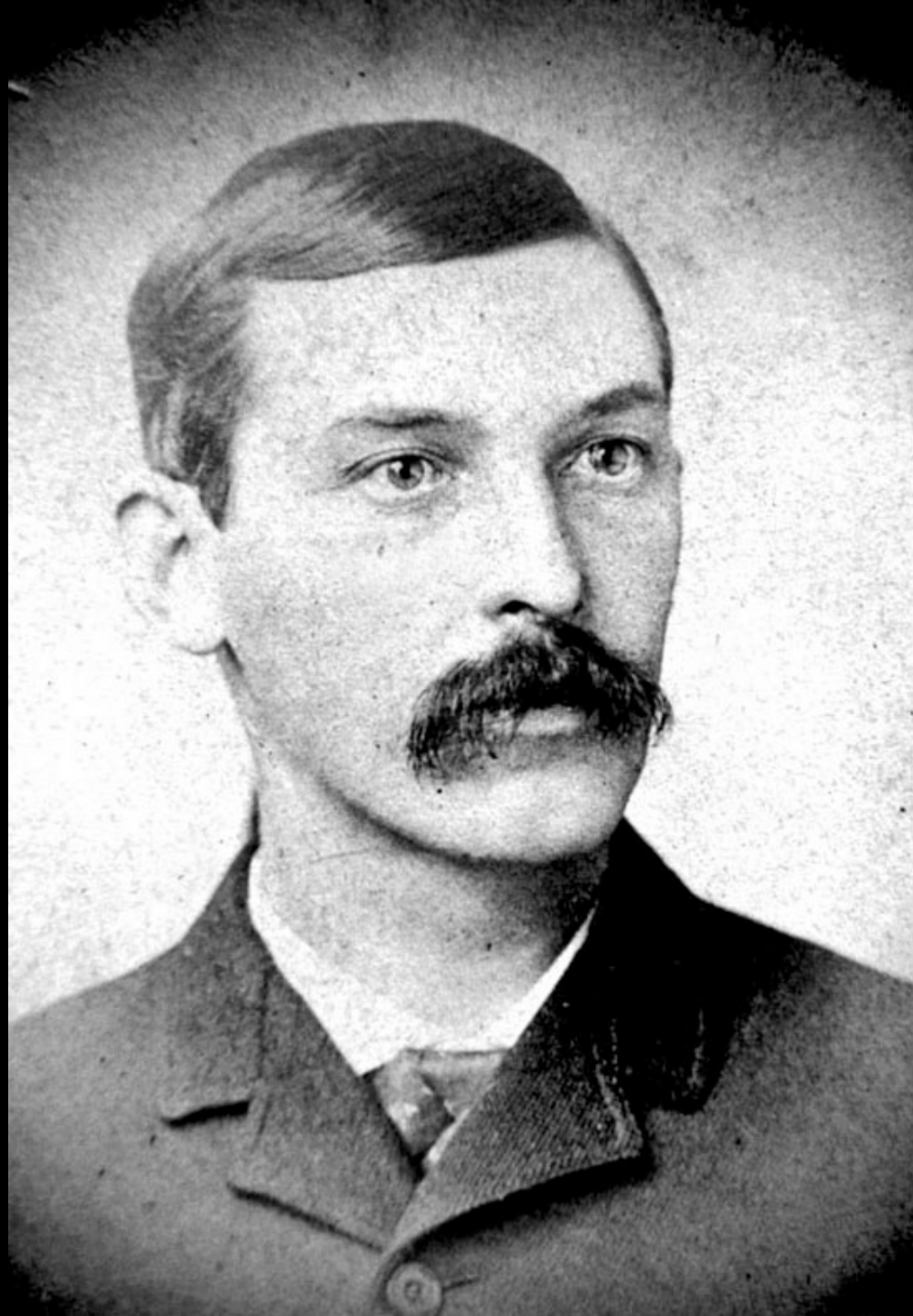

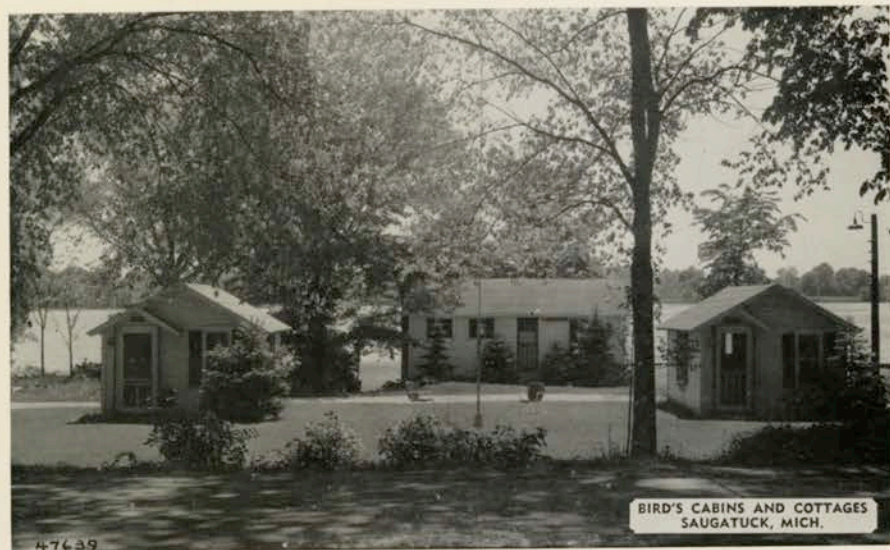
The dining room and kitchens are in a separate building, and are always open to inspection, and our tables are the best the season affords.

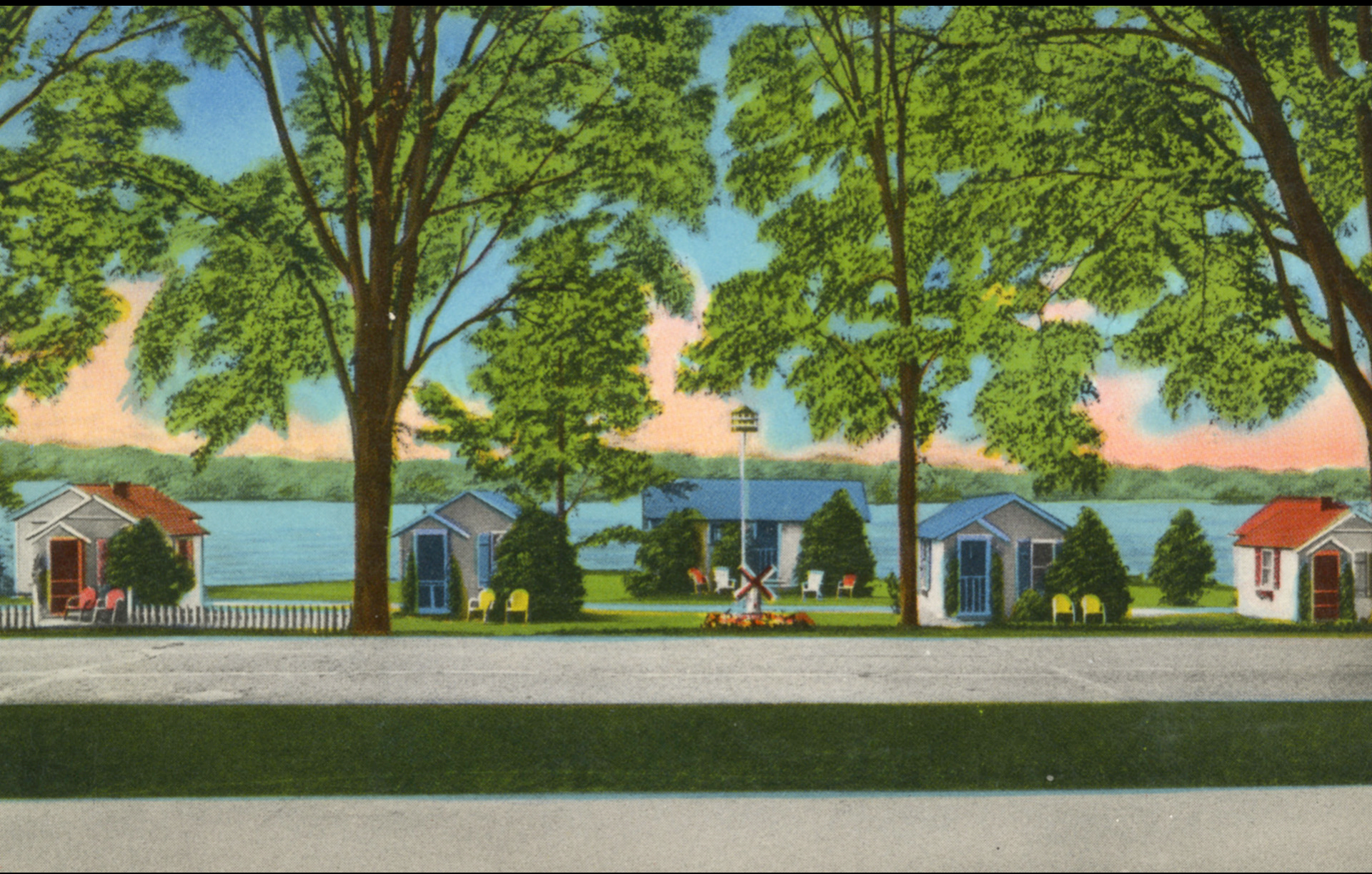

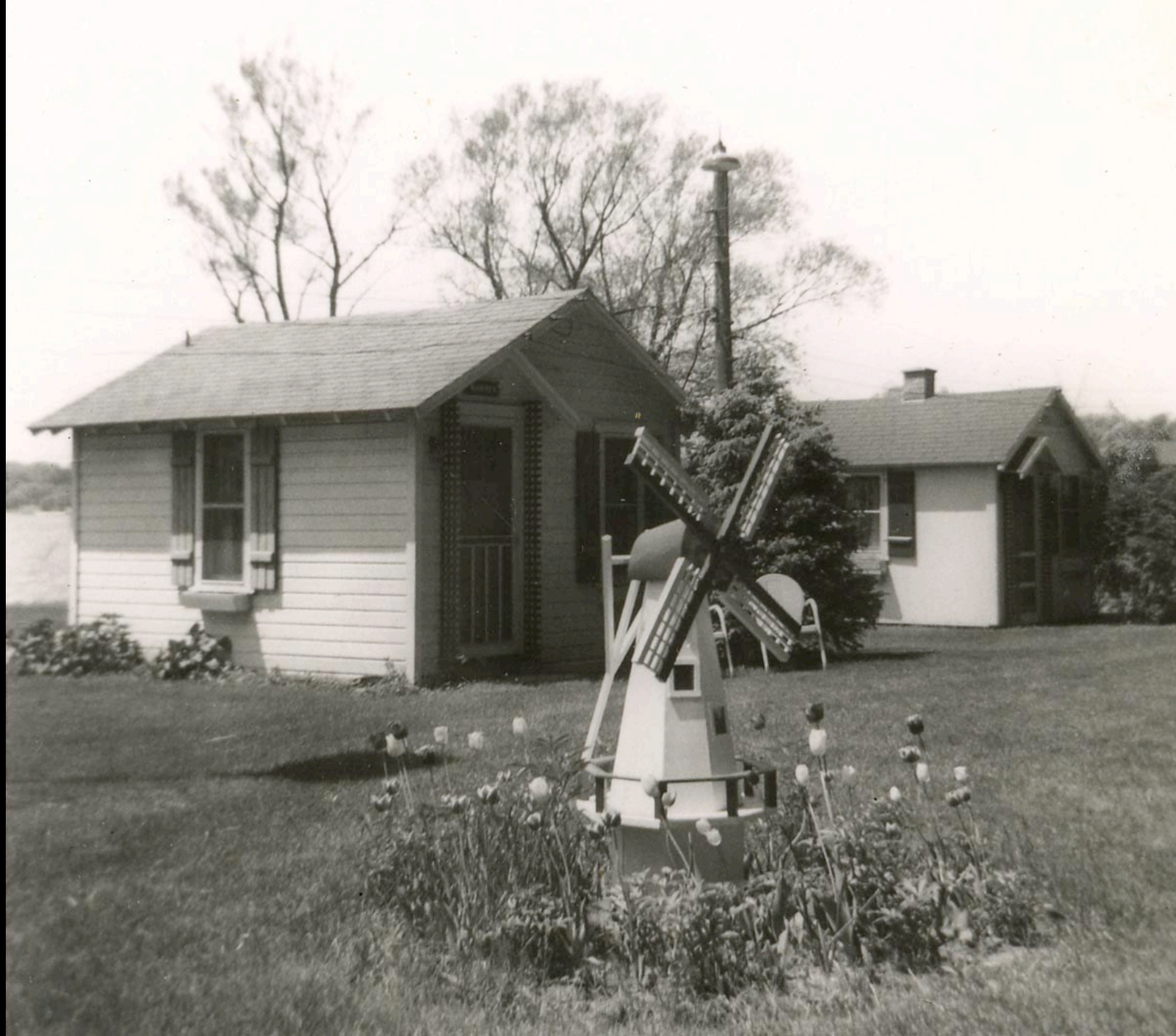

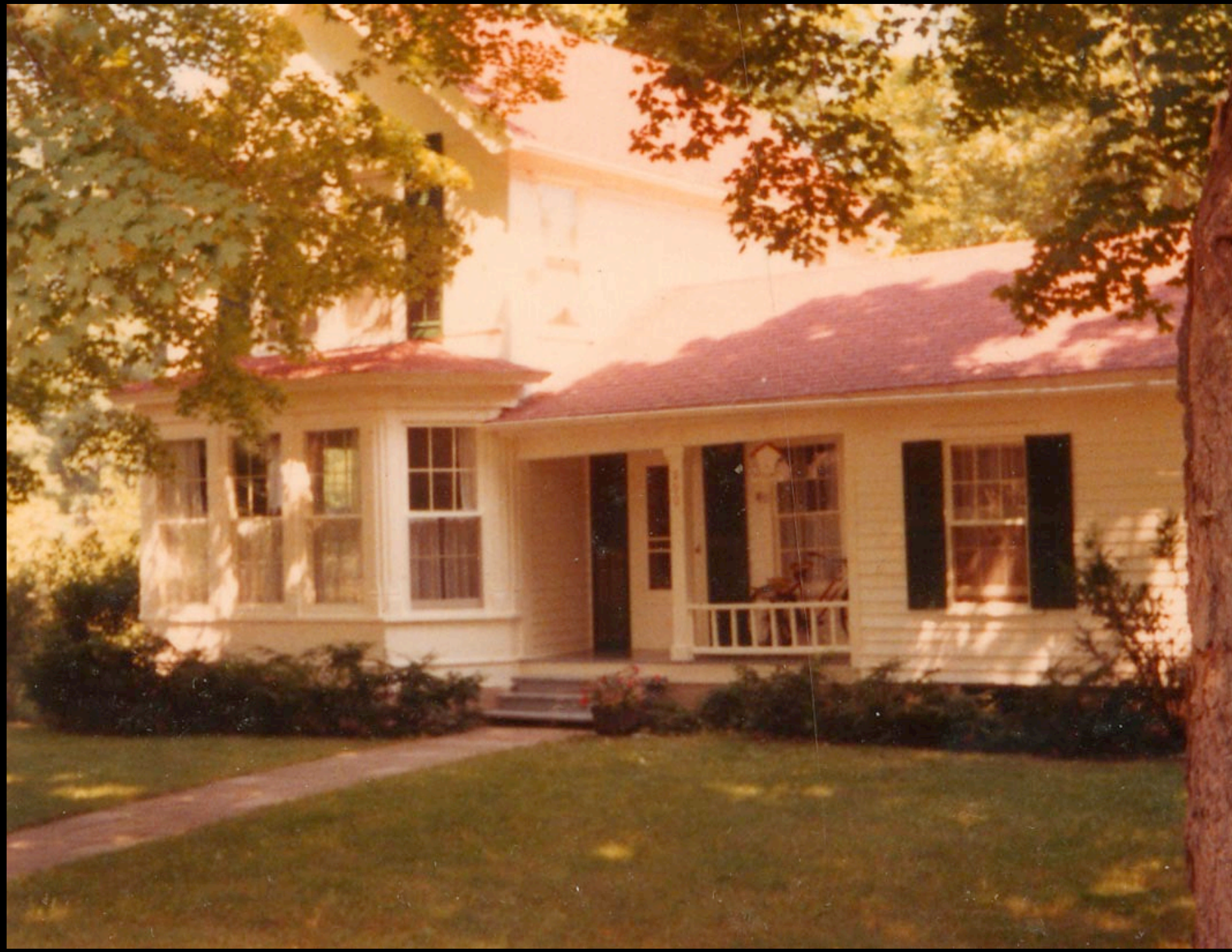
