Check out the many ways we re-cycle the old to build a new "green" garden.

- Reshape the landscape to capture water
- Underground rainwater harvest system stores 1,000+ gallons of water for garden drip irrigation
- Reclaimed driveway concrete for foot paths and patio
- Permeable pathways and pavers reduce water flow to sewer and lake
- Recycle damaged trees as garden benches
- "Rain garden" captures excess surface water
- Use of native species throughout (not exclusively)
- Sign posts fabricated from trees on property
- Reuse of School House blackboards in Children's Garden
- Recycled local compost as liquid fertilizer
- Keeping it "local" by using local landscapers, artists, designers-writers, builders, and eco-garden professionals
