There's a reason why we're known as the "Art Coast" of Michigan.® Discover the creative culture that embodies our heart and soul with a thriving art scene rich in visual and performing arts.

Over a century ago, art students from The Art Institute of Chicago rebelled against the traditional practice of in-studio painting and started teaching summer painting classes here on the east bank of the Kalamazoo River. This led to the establishment of the Ox-Bow School of Art in 1910, which has been drawing in artists from around the country ever since.

Today, dozens of working painters, sculptors, ceramicists, and other artists call the Saugatuck/Douglas/Fennville area home. We invite you to wander through our many galleries and studios, where you'll encounter fine art in every medium from a mix of local and national artists.

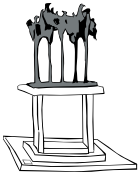

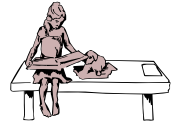

Our little corner of the world has a vibrant arts scene that's ready to inspire and enthrall. From live theater and musical performances to art exhibits and organized gallery strolls, there's something soul-stirring happening in every season.

1 Gallery Strolls

Stroll through dozens of galleries and artists' studios as they extend their hours and feature special exhibits and activities. Chat with the artists, watch live demonstrations, enjoy live music, and sample delicious local bites and refreshments while expanding your artistic tastes.

2 Art Exhibitions

Explore curated works from emerging and established artists from around the region and the country with art exhibitions that aim to enlighten, provoke thought, and ignite your imagination.

3 Art Fairs & Makers Markets

Two juried outdoor art fairs are held each year in July, the Waterfront Invitational Fine Art Fair and the Village Square Arts and Crafts Fair, showcasing the work of fine artists from around the nation. Year-round, artisan markets can be found in various venues offering visitors the opportunity to peruse the booths of local and regional makers for treasures to take home.

4 Live Performances

Thanks to the **Saugatuck Center for the Arts (SCA)**, visitors can enjoy a variety of stage productions and world-class concerts typically found in big-city cultural experiences. Throughout the area, numerous indoor and outdoor venues regularly feature live musical performances.

5 Film Festivals

Each Spring, the "Art Out Loud" film festival features award-winning documentaries that debuted at the Mountainfilm Festival in Telluride, Colorado. Organized by the SCA, this is the only place in Michigan—and one of a handful of select cities across the country—where you can view these films on the big screen. And join us each fall as the frontier of independent filmmaking is celebrated during our annual Saugatuck Film Fest.
