

Richard Brown, 72, of Saugatuck died Thursday, Sept. 1, in his home. 1988

Mr. Brown was born and raised in Saugatuck and attended Saugatuck schools. He graduated from Western Michigan University and was employed as an office manager for L.J. Harris Pie Co. of Saugatuck. He also worked for William P. DeLong and Company of Holland.

Mr. Brown was a World War II Air Corps veteran and a member of the First Congregational Church of

Saugatuck. He was a member of the Saladin Shrine of Grand Rapids and a life member of the Masonic Lodge of Saugatuck.

Surviving are a sister Beatrice Finch of Saugatuck, a niece Mrs. Sandra Milosevich of East Aurora, N.Y.; three grandnieces, Dr. Pamela Milosevich of Montpelier, Vt., Mrs. James (Lynn) McKenna of Cincinnati, Ohio, and Miss Jeanette Milosevich of Athens, Ohio; and two great-grandnephews John and Tom McKenna of

Cincinnati.

Graveside services with Masonic rights were Sunday, Sept. 4 at Riverside Cemetery, Saugatuck. The Rev. Hanscom Clarence officiated.


