

McVay Cemetery Tombstone Inscriptions
Read by Candice Buchanan and Glenn Toothman
Spring 2014 (Updated Summer 2016)

INTRODUCTION

To the best of our ability, the following is a list of tombstone inscriptions quoted exactly as they appear on the grave markers of McVay Cemetery in Aleppo Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania. These tombstones were read by Candice Buchanan and Glenn Toothman on 23 March 2014. This reading was rechecked during an additional visit on 3 April 2014 in order to make the most of light and weather conditions for each stone. Difficult inscriptions were carefully examined to render the most accurate transcription possible.

McVay Cemetery tombstone data has been recorded at least twice before in published records, as follows:

Hamilton, Rosalie. *Burials of Aleppo Township, Greene Co., Pa.*. Apollo, Pennsylvania: Closson Press, 1985.

Hennen, Dorothy T., compiler. *Cemetery Records of Greene County, Pennsylvania*. 12 volumes. Waynesburg, Pennsylvania: Cornerstone Genealogical Society, 1975. (Hennen did not read the cemetery herself, she referenced tombstone data recorded by Patty Houston in McVay Cemetery on 20 April 1952.)

These readings are very valuable and useful to compare against the present reading, particularly for tombstones that can no longer be located, can no longer be read, or can be read only in part. However, many errors in both the Hamilton and Hennen publications were discovered during this research. At times, the two recordings contradict each other as well as the current assessment.

In order to provide the best evidence possible to accompany the transcriptions presented here and to allow each researcher to make their own examination, every tombstone was also photographed and these images are available to view for free online at any of the following web sites:

TOMBSTONE INSCRIPTIONS

The following tombstones still stand in McVay Cemetery as of Spring 2014 and were read, as follows:

// = inscription for an additional person (many stones have several people listed on one marker)

ADAMS

Name: Isaac Adams
Inscription: Isaac Adams tombstone still stands, but it is almost illegible. Just enough of the inscription could be discerned to match up the marker with previous cemetery readings, thus allowing us to know it was his grave.

Research Note: The Hamilton record identifies this Elizabeth as the wife of Seabury Black, but that is incorrect. This Elizabeth is the daughter of Seabury Black and his wife, Elizabeth (Courtwright) Black. After Seabury Black's death, his widow Elizabeth (Courtwright) Black remarried to Noah Whipkey. She is also buried in McVay Cemetery and is clearly a different person than this Elizabeth Black. *See Elizabeth (Courtwright) (Black) Whipkey entry.*

Research Note: The death date on Lydia's tombstone, 9 March 1934, is clearly an error since her obituary was run in the *Democrat Messenger* of Waynesburg, Pennsylvania, 6 March 1934. The death date 2 March 1934 provided in the obituary and also on her PA state death record is most likely the accurate date.
