The 1st entitled "My father came to Cape May" is a beach scene with her brother & Don Harmon on the beach, a group of bathing beauties in "gay 90's" bathing garb in the surf & the party sail boat "Polly Page" & a commercial boat in the background. Another has a photo of her mother Mariandugalls & friend Florence Gracie against a background of the old Elberon Hotel & the nunnery at the Point. The 3rd has a photo of her at the age of about 9 plus vintage fashionable paper dolls, etc with a background of Congress Hall & Moon's drugstore, etc, etc. Each is matted in lace paper doily designs. Well, you get the idea any way, & then she's blended the montages together with appropriate colorings!!! By the way 2 other artists we've been planning to tell you about are: At Sandman's "2 Mile Crab-House" the very attractive murals were done by Polly Perkins, art teacher at Stockton College; The murals, now this year at the "Golden Whale" swimming pool are by Bill Browning, the same guy that did all the rest of the murals including the one at the "Top of the Mark"!
