Perseus is also named after a constellation of stars. He appears as a man holding a round object away from him.

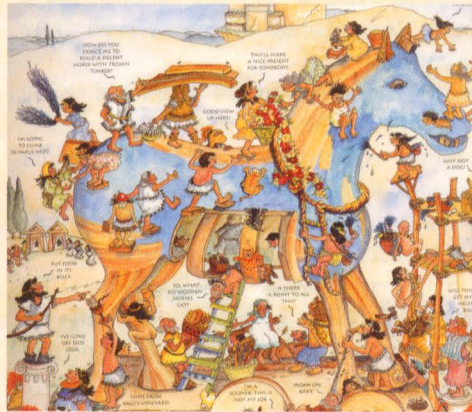
