

Recognizing Taylor Park

Taylor Park, one of the Township's prime assets which has been relatively unappreciated for too many years, may come into its proper status if some of the recommendations made by Kendree and Shepherd, the Planning Board's planning consultants, are adopted in the future.

According to the consultants, "New community facilities that serve the entire Township should be located in Millburn Center. They should be grouped around Taylor Park, which should be the focus of the community — —the Millburn equivalent of the New England 'common' or 'green'." We heartily concur in that statement.

Obviously such a development cannot take place overnight and perhaps it may never take place at all, but certainly the idea is exciting and well worthy of serious study and consideration by Township authorities and others interested in improving Millburn's image.

Details of the consultant's recommendations on this and other facets of the Township's development and improvement will be discussed in detail at a public meeting at Millburn High School next Wednesday at 8 p.m. Residents and business people from all sections of the Township should be interested in attending.
