

The Township of Millburn will be conducting a municipal-wide reassessment of all real estate property. Reassessment is a periodic program undertaken in order to appraise all real estate in terms of its full and fair market value. Also known as tax equalization, reassessment insures that all property owners pay their fair share of taxes based on the actual market value of the property they own.

To help residents better understand the reassessment process, we have prepared
