

Hoover Dam Pioneer Buried in Kingman

Dec. 15, 1977 — **George Fradett**

One day when the Boulder City News was located at 555 Ave. C, a visitor to Boulder City wandered into the NEWS office and announced that he was George Fradett, high-scaler on the great Hoover Dam during its construction. He inquired for other high-scalers in the area but the writer of the article, Dorothy See, was not acquainted with the town and told him she was sorry but she indeed knew of no other high-

scalers.

George went back to Kingman and never sent his address. In town living at the time was Joe Kine and Dan McKenzie, both high-scalers who probably worked right beside Mr. George Fradett.

This week the NEWS received a letter from Mrs. Fradett and its contents were that George had died and she would like an announcement made in the Boulder City News.
