

# Funeral Services To Be Monday For Mrs. Vaughan

**BOULDER CITY** — Mrs. Gertrude Helen Vaughan, 70, a long time resident of Boulder City, died Thursday in St. Mary's Corwin Hospital in Pueblo, Colo., it was learned here. Funeral services will be held in St. Andrew's Catholic Church in Boulder City.

Mrs. Vaughan, who made her home in Boulder City with her son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. George Vaughan, 647 Ave. C, had been visiting friends in Pueblo when she became ill and was admitted to the hospital a week previous to her death.

Mrs. Vaughan was born June 28, 1890, in Stillwater, Minn. She was graduated from high school there and from the state normal school in Superior, Wis., where she taught school for a number of years.

She was married to Lyle T. Vaughan on June 16, 1910. They came to Boulder City in 1933 shortly after construction was started on Boulder Dam. He died here in 1948.

Mrs. Vaughan was employed at the Bureau of Mines for several years and later worked at the Boulder City Hospital as a practical nurse. She retired about five
