Subject: Survey of School Facilities, needs and problems of the Boulder City School District.

Due to the fact that the situation in Boulder City as it relates to our schools is unique, and entirely different from situations that prevail in any other section of the country, we would like to take this means of formally presenting a statement of our problems in detail in order that they may be fully understood, and that there may be no misunderstanding between us and those on whom we are dependent for the support and maintenance of our schools.

The past service of the Commissioner of the Bureau of Reclamation in the Boulder City School District will give him a partial first hand knowledge of the conditions which prevail here. Much which we present will, therefore, be repetition of that knowledge, but in order to present our problems fairly to you, and through you to him, we beg your indulgence in making a study of this analytical survey.

There is at the present time a bill awaiting action of Congress whereby money will be available, subject to the order of the Secretary of the Interior, for the purposes of constructing school buildings and facilities in Boulder City such as are outlined in the attached survey.
