Funeral services for John Arthur Williamson, 72, were held Tuesday afternoon at Bunker Brothers Chapel. Burial followed in the Memory Gardens. Mr. Williamson died early Saturday morning at his home, 4820 Serene Drive, Las Vegas.

He was born May 12, 1893 in LaPort, Ind. Williamson was a veteran of World War I. He came to Las Vegas when he was 20 years old. He later moved to Boulder City, and worked as a pump operator on Boulder Dam until his retirement 15 years ago.
