Boulder City, Nevada, October 30—Edward Holgren, for the past two years construction engineer at Shasta and Keswick Dams, has been appointed construction engineer to supervise installation of additional generating equipment at Hoover Dam, it was announced today by L. R. Douglass, Director of Power, Boulder Canyon Project. Holgren reported for duty at Boulder City October 23.

Holgren was among the first to be employed on the huge Shasta Dam, where he began work with the Bureau of Reclamation in 1936. For several years prior to his promotion to construction engineer on that project, he served as office engineer under Irving C. Harris and W. J. McCrystle.

Holgren is married and the father of three children. His family plans to join him in Boulder City later.
