

DAM WORKER IS KILLED IN FREAK ACCIDENT TODAY

Form Gives Way, Dumps
Tons Of New Concrete
On Him; Another Hurt

Boulder Dam worker, was at the wrong place at the wrong instant, about 3:30 this morning, and as a result is believed to have been swept to his death at the bottom of the "slot" thru the center of the dam structure when a form on column J-13 gave way sending a shower of freshly placed concrete pouring down, sweeping away scaffolding, water and refrigeration pipes as it went.
