

# DEATH CAUSE IS RETURNED

A coroner's jury last night brought a verdict that Frank Manning and M. J. "Sid" Sidmore came to their deaths as result of a premature explosion caused by a defective fuse, inserted by M. J. Sidmore, who was jointly employed in the performance of his duty as a miner by the Six Companies on Boulder Dam.

Sidmore and Manning were killed by a blast which caught them in an anchor belt tunnel on the Nevada side Tuesday morning. Sidmore was killed outright, while Manning died Wednesday morning from a fractured skull.

Mrs. Sidmore is expected here from San Francisco Friday.
