

Boulder Engineer Gets New Reclamation Post

BOULDER CITY — LeRoy Nicholson, Bureau of Reclamation engineer, left Wednesday for Yuma, Ariz., where he will assume duties as chief of operations and engineering on the bureau's Yuma Project, it was learned from Region 3 director Wade H. Taylor.

He will be working under Project Manager William A. Steenbergen.

Since coming to Boulder City in September, 1954, he has been irrigation operations engineer in the Regional Irrigation Division headed by A. B. West, irrigation supervisor.
