

# Ed Workman

Ed Workman, 84, a former long-time resident of Henderson and Boulder City, died Sunday, April 18, 2004, at St. James Healthcare in Butte, Mont.

He was born May 6, 1919, in Ohio to Orlen and Hazel (Kirkpatrick) Workman. He was educated in Ohio before moving to Boulder City, where he drove tanker trucks from Las Vegas to Los Angeles. He obtained his commercial maritime license and ran hotel boats at the Flamingo and Riviera hotels, taking people on Lake Mead. He worked twice

at the test site at Mercury and operated a dude ranch in Canyon Creek near Melrose, Mont. He bought property at Mammoth in 1964 and moved to Montana full time in 1968 upon retiring.

He married Lucy Smee Dec. 18, 1938, in Las Vegas.

Ed belonged to the First Christian Church at Whitehall, Teamsters Union Local 631 at Las Vegas, and Elks Lodge.
