

Dam Worker Killed In 50 Foot Plunge

Plunging some 50 feet from pier number five of the Arizona penstock tunnel, Robert Grant, 41, form scripper for Six Companies Inc., met instant death last night shortly after seven o'clock. He suffered a broken neck and a fractured skull.

Grant was missed at lunch time last evening, by his partner, who informed the foreman and the latter started a search for the missing man, finding him dead at the bottom of the pier.

The deceased is survived by a mother, in Mississippi City, Mississippi, and an estranged wife and daughter in Jackson, Mississippi. He had been employed on the job since June 27, 1932.

The body is at Parks' Mortuary in Boulder City and funeral arrangements will be announced later.
