

# Steeves Funeral Held Here This Afternoon

BOULDER CITY, Nov. 19 — Final rites for William W. Steeves, pioneer Boulder City resident who died at the Boulder City hospital Sunday at the age of 79, were held at 3 o'clock this afternoon at Grace Community church with the Reverend Winston Traver officiating.

The Grace church mixed quartet, Mrs. Walter Swartz, Mrs. James Harvey, Otto Littler and Charles Sweet, sang "Safe in the Arms of Jesus," and "Abide With Me." Organ music was played by Miss Natalie Bellami.

Pall bearers were members of the Boulder City ranger force with which Steeves had served as a watchman until his retirement two years ago. They were Captain John R. Weiler, Captain Michael J. Slattery, and Rangers Ed Grandpre, C. B. Kirby, Orvil Martin and Berney J. White.

Interment was in the Boulder City cemetery beside the grave of his wife who died three months ago at the family home, 635 Avenue F
