

# Charles Wyatt Sr. Boulder Pioneer Dies At 80 Years

BOULDER CITY — Word of the death of a Boulder City pioneer, Charles Wyatt Sr., 80, on Monday at his home in El Cajon, Calif., was received by friends here.

Funeral services will be held Thursday at 10 a.m. at the Paris Mortuary in El Cajon.

The Wyatts have been living in El Cajon since his retirement from the Union Pacific Railroad. He was the first agent here in 1931 when the railroad was built to the Hoover Dam construction camp.

Active pioneer workers and charter members of the Grace Community Church, the Wyatts drove up from El Cajon for the 25th Anniversary celebration of the church this year.

He was the first member chosen on the church council and the first moderator of the church. She was the second president of the Ladies Aid.
