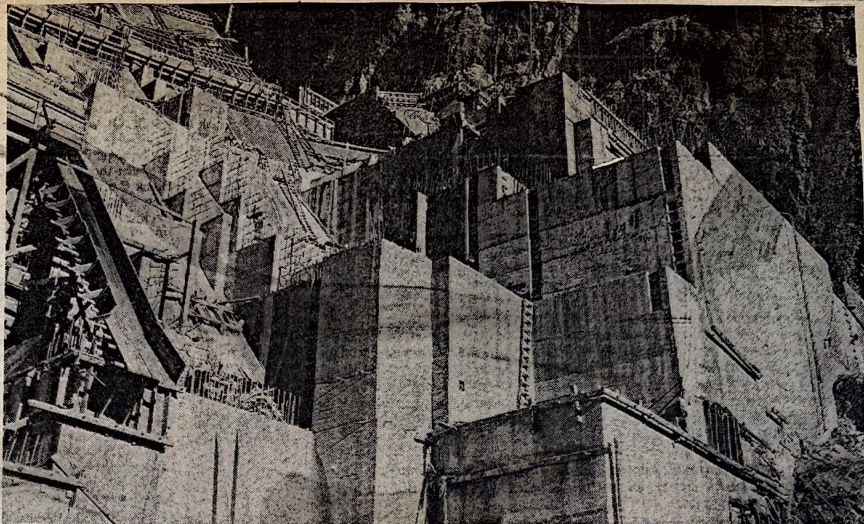

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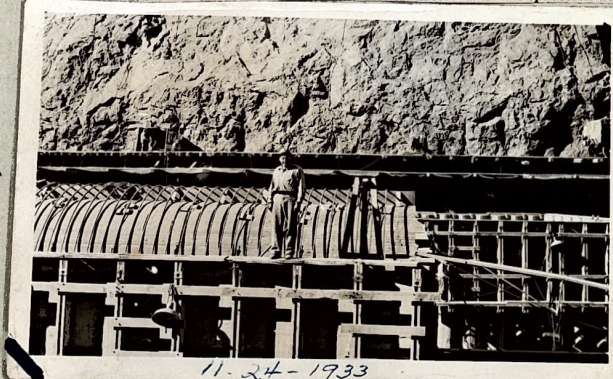
A BIG job — when U.S. needed it most
