

Police Chief Barlow BOOKED In Las Vegas For Driving Under Influence Of LIQUOR

Jack Barlow, police chief of Boulder City, was booked for driving under the influence of liquor by Las Vegas police officers, Leo Kuykendall, police chief of Las Vegas confirmed to the Boulder City NEWS last night.

The incident happened at 9:14 p.m. on August 8 in the vicinity of 21st street. Chief Barlow was picked up and booked by officers after the truck he was driving hit a car owned by Larry Bush of Foster Av., Pittman.

The police officers' report stated that Barlow was driving under the influence of liquor, Kuykendall told the NEWS.

The truck he drove was owned by Charles Weaver, a Boulder City police officer on Barlow's staff. Trial has been set for Sept. 26.
