

Otto Kraning Dies of Heart Trouble

Otto Kraning, former Boulderite, passed away Thursday evening at his home, 815 S. E. Division street, Portland, Oregon, from a heart attack, according to word received by his daughter, Mrs. John E. Selvala, of Boulder City.

Mr. Kraning worked here for the Bureau of Reclamation from May, 1933 to April 1941, as laborer and truck driver.

He is survived by his wife of Portland, and three daughters: Mrs. John E. Selvala of 520 Seventh street, Boulder City; Mrs. Paul Mitchell of Portland, and Mrs. David Anderson, Provo, South Dakota. Funeral services will probably be held in Portland next Monday.

Mr. and Mrs. Selvala left Gridley night to attend funeral services, expecting to remain in Portland for the duration.
