

No Fatalities In Plane Crash

Four Marines and their pilot on a routine training flight from El Toro Marine base in California escaped death yesterday afternoon, when their J.R.B. Beachcraft plane crashed in the desert a few hundred feet from the Boulder City airport. The pilot, who states that no official details can be issued now because of regulations, reports that he lost an engine while taking off, and that the wheels were knocked off when the plane landed.

The men received bruises and scratches, but no apparent serious injuries, according to Zane Pauley and Doc Jensen, who responded to the ambulance call.
