6. Exterior Appearance: Planed lumber with two-inch iron nails
insulated with aluminum siding and a
shingled roof. The original car port
was turned into a bedroom and another
bedroom and utility room were built
in the back of the house in 1950. A
chain-link fence was built in 1958 and
a brick wall in 1970. An awning was
added to the back patio in 1968. The
house is surrounded by a lawn of winter
rye grass. There is a plywood shed and
an aluminum shed in the back yard. The
house is forty-seven feet from the
street to the east, and the house has
an alley to the south.
7. Interior Appearance: The entire inside of the house is
painted except for the ceilings and the
wood panelling in the living room and
hall. The ceilings are varnished pine
wood. The windows are sliding glass
and the floors are tile, except for the
bed room off the hall that has deep,
green shag carpet. There are seven rooms
and a hall. There is one bathroom that
had a tub and shower added in 1968.
The kitchen is original and there are no
fireplaces. The house is cooled by an
