

# Paul Scott Rites Scheduled Today At Grace Church

Paul Dean Scott, 62, died on Monday at his home, 708 Sixth Street, following a long illness. His death was the result of lung collapse caused by inhaling titanium vapors while working as a metallurgist for the Bureau of Mines several years ago. He is the third of four laboratory workers who have given their lives because it was not known at that time that fumes given off from this metal were poisonous.

Services will be held at 11 this morning in Grace Community Church with the Rev. Earl Fox officiating. Bunker Brothers is in charge of arrangements and following the service, Scott's body will be shipped to San Bernardino, Calif., for cremation.

Scott was born August 13, 1896 in Owasso, Mich., and is survived by his widow, Mary Singleton Scott.
