

Funeral Held Mon. For M. Spearman

Funeral rites were held Monday morning for Millard Joseph Spearman, 76, who died Feb. 22 after a long illness. The Rev. Hugh P. Smith of St. Andrew's Catholic Church officiated. Military graveside services were conducted at the Boulder City Cemetery by American Legion Post No. 31.

Mr. Spearman was born July 8, 1896, in Keokuk, Iowa. He served in the U.S. Army in World War 1. He was employed as an iron worker for the Guy P. Atkinson construction company in Ohio, before coming to Nevada during the building of the Dam. He worked for Six Companies, and Babcock & Wilcox. During World War 2,

he was an iron worker at Henderson.

In 1947, the Spearman family moved to Oregon and enjoyed farm life there for many years.

Nina and Millard "Pappy" Spearman had two sons, who attended Boulder High School.

Millard Jr. preceded his father in death. Nina and son Gordon live in Hermiston, Oregon. Other survivors are a brother, Harvey Spearman; a sister, Nellie Nelson; four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
