

A survey to provide a basis for evaluating the effect of existing methods of government housing administration, on employee relations is now underway in Boulder City, it was announced Thursday by Regional Director E. A. Moritz, of the Bureau of Reclamation.

Glenn D. Thompson, the Bureau's Chief Personnel Officer, Washington, D. C., and Frank H. Knapp, of the Bureau's Region 2 Operation and Maintenance staff, Sacramento, California, arrived this week to conduct the survey, which is the first of a series to be made in Reclamation communities throughout the west, Mr. Moritz said. They will examine procedures and administration of assignments of Government quarters and submit a report to the Commissioner. Data obtained here and in other Bureau communities will determine future policies with regard to housing furnished Government employees, the official said.
