

Ivan Zuzek Wins Coveted Award at Camp

The Boulder City Twin CCC Camps lost a good man and its top-kick last week when Ivan A. Zuzek, enrolled in Company 573 since April 1939, was discharged for employment with the Bureau of Mines in Boulder City.

Zuzek, since his enrollment in 1939 has made a reputation for himself in camp as a conscientious workman and leader of men. He held a rating of assistant leader from April 1940 until he was made full leader in January 1941. As senior leader for several months he showed his leadership in many ways leading to his being presented, upon his discharge, with the Twin Camps Honor Award for Loyalty, Character and Service. This is an honor which few men receive.

During his enrollment Zuzek won the respect and liking of his fellow enrollees and the officers of the camp.
