

# Services This Morning for Earl F. Tucker

Funeral services will be held this morning for Earl F. Tucker, safety engineer for the Bureau of Reclamation, who died suddenly Saturday evening of a heart attack. He had been suffering heart trouble for nearly three years.

Mr. and Mrs. Tucker were on their way to dine with friends Saturday evening about 6:15 o'clock. While driving along Arizona street, Mrs. Tucker heard a gasp and noticed that Mr. Tucker had turned ashen pale and was unconscious. She turned the car to the curb in front of the Sweet Shop and called for help. Mary Telford, technician at the Professional building, heard her call and immediately responded. Although preliminary examination indicated death had already occurred, Mr. Tucker was carried into the Professional building by Sergeant Perlle Morris of the ranger force where Dr. D. M. MacCornack verified his death.
