

Construction Pioneer Rupert Spearman Transferred to New Post in Colorado

One of the pioneers in the construction of Hoover Dam has left Boulder City after 23 years of residence. He is Rupert B. Spearman, Chief of the Civil Engineering Branch, Boulder Canyon Project, who left last week to work in another office of the Bureau of Reclamation in Durango, Colo.
