Michael O. Lopez Dies Here Friday Morning

Michael O. Lopez, assistant electric power plant operator for the Department of Water and Power, died yesterday at 8:10 a.m. at Boulder City hospital.

Death was caused by coronary occlusion, due to septic thrombophlebitis.

Lopez was transferred to Boulder City July 19, 1944, from Los Angeles, where he had been employed by the department for about three years prior to his transfer.

Lopez and his wife, whom he married about a month ago, lived at 654 Avenue I.

The body is at the Palm funeral home, pending further arrangements.
