# Boulder City Pioneer Passes Away; Burial To Be in Salt Lake City

Lyman A. Wilcox passed away Thursday evening at 10:50 o'clock at the Boulder City hospital, where he was taken a few days ago. Mr. Wilcox had been in ill health for several months and his condition became critical three weeks ago. The body is at the Garrison Mortuary in Las Vegas. Funeral services will be in charge of the Masonic Lodge of Boulder City and will be held Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock at Grace Community church. The body will then be sent to Salt Lake City for interment.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Bessie Wilcox. Mr. and Mrs. Wilcox have lived in Boulder City ten years and their home was at 308 Nevada highway.

Mr. Wilcox was employed for one year by Babcock & Wilcox company when he first came here, later transferring to the Bureau of Reclamation as general foreman at the dam, which position he has held for the past nine years.
