

# Vegas Transfer Head Stricken at Age 71

Clarence Irving Wadsworth, owner of Las Vegas Transfer and Storage Co. and a Las Vegas resident for over 30 years, is dead at the age of 71.

Mr. Wadsworth died Saturday in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Hospital in Salt Lake City after a lingering illness.

He came to Las Vegas in 1931 and bought Las Vegas Transfer and Storage the fol-

lowing year. He was a rancher in Lincoln County before moving to Las Vegas, and once owned grocery stores in Caliente and Alamo.

He operated buses to Boulder Dam during its construction, carrying between eight and 10 passengers on up to 20 trips a day.
