

Addition to Bank Building to Be Started Monday

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Ground will be broken Monday for construction of an addition to the Bank of Nevada Building.

Receipt of authorization from the Civilian Production Administration was announced today by Earl Brothers, owner of the Visitors Bureau.

The 50 by 75 foot unit added to the east side of the bank building will be occupied by the Nevada Drug Co., and the Visitors Bureau will expand into the present drug store quarters.

The bus depot will be moved around the corner to C St.

Contractor for the new building is Miller, Haynes & Smith of Henderson.

W. E. Ferron, owner, and Everett Cunningham, manager of the drug company said the new store will be modern in design and decoration, and will be air-conditioned.
