

D. Parks 1st Passenger By B. C. Airplane

Dr. J. B. Parks, Boulder City dentist, was the first airplane passenger out of Boulder City, and the first airplane passenger to land in Boulder, having recently made a round trip to Los Angeles and back with Noel Bullock, permit holder for construction and operation of the Boulder air field.

Dr. Parks' first airplane ride, which also was Boulders first passenger plane ride, ended a Saturday evening when Bullock landed at the air field here after two hours in the air on the trip from Los Angeles to Boulder City, down past the dam site for two circles over the canyon and back to Boulder.

The trip was made between 3:30 and 5:20 from L. A. to Boulder the additional ten minutes being taken for the trip over the canyon.
